The library's wireless access is unfiltered and unsecured; therefore any information being sent or received could be intercepted by another wireless user. Please take appropriate precautions.

Library staff is able to provide limited technical assistance and the library makes no guarantee that you will be able to make a wireless connection.

The library does not assume responsibility for the safety of equipment, security, or configuration of wireless devices, nor does it assume liability for any damages to hardware, software, or data.
