

3D Printing!

What can I print?

You can make your own design or download one someone else has published! Check out created designs on [Thingiverse.com](https://www.thingiverse.com) or create your own design on [Tinkercad.com](https://www.tinkercad.com)!

How do I use the printer?

Once you find or create your design, download the .stl file and send it to cpawlak@biblio.org. Specify the color you would like us to use in the email. We will get back to you as soon as possible and confirm that your print is in the queue. If you have any questions on this step, we can help.

What size objects can I print?

At the Wolcott Library, the maximum dimension you can print is 6" x 6" x 6".

How long will it take to print my file?

Very small designs may take several minutes to print, but bigger designs may take several hours. We can give you an estimate of how long your print may take upon receiving your file.

How much does printing cost?

At our library, it costs 25 cents per 15 minutes of printing.
